OF THE SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON THE CHARTER OF THE UNITED
NATIONS AND ON THE STRENGTHENING OF THE ROLE OF THE
ORGANIZATION AT THE SIXTH COMMITTEE OF THE
72nd SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, NEW YORK, 10
OCTOBER 2017

Mr. Chairman,

1. Malaysia notes with appreciation the Report of the Special Committee on the Charter of the United Nations and on the Strengthening of the Role of the Organization .
2. Malaysia's commitment is reflected by its involvement in the Bureau of the Special Committee which also serves as the Bureau of the Working Group of the Whole. Further, Malaysia actively reviews the proposals and annexes that are submitted and provides its input, when necessary.

3. The Report of the Special Committee provides several useful proposals that should be deliberated until we could finally adopt them. Nevertheless, Malaysia is concerned with the number of items that this Special Committee has to consider as they may cloud the focus of the Committee and eventually disrupt the progress that has been

made thus far. Malaysia will continue to be part of this beneficial endeavour within this Special Committee and look forward to finding the best methods to further develop the work done.

Malaysia notes that in the first part of the Report, which focuses on “The Maintenance of International Peace and Security”, the Special Committee is required to consider at least six (6) proposals or papers. After perusing those papers, there seems to be some considerable overlaps which could be avoided by merging some of those proposals or papers. Therefore, Malaysia would like to suggest for the Special Committee to look into this matter and make an appropriate review.

5. Malaysia also commends the continuing efforts of the Secretariat to update the Repertory of Practice of United Nations Organs and the Repertoire of the Practice of the Security. Malaysia believes this effort will assist members in understanding the application and practice of the United Nations and the Security Council.
