Ministry of Defence and Army of Montenegro fully comply with the provisions of the Geneva Conventions of 1949 and the Additional Protocols to the Conventions. Through a regular process of planning and training, military staff of the Army of Montenegro gets acquainted with the significance and implementation of the mentioned international instruments, as well as other international treaties in the field of international humanitarian law, relating to the protection of the wounded and diseased, humanitarian and medical staff and medical facilities. Special attention is paid to the protection of children and women in armed conflicts and to the measures on prevention of sexual violence. As regards the trainings on international humanitarian law, the Ministry of Defence and the Army of Montenegro usually send their officers to international institutions. In 2018, 10 officers from the Ministry of Defence attended an international military course at the International Institute of Humanitarian Law in San Remo, Italy.
