

**Statement by Turkey
on Agenda Item 85 (The Law of Transboundary Aquifers)
at the Sixth Committee**

**22 October 2019
New York**

Mr. Chairman,

Turkey is of the view that each transboundary aquifer has its own specific characteristics and peculiarities, and that it would not be appropriate to apply a single framework to all transboundary aquifers.

On this basis, we believe that work on the law of transboundary aquifers should focus on the general principles, and that the draft articles should continue to serve as voluntary guidance for state practice, in their current non-binding form.
