



General Assembly of the United Nations Sixth Committee (Legal)

Seventy-sixth session (2021)

Website of the Sixth Committee (<http://www.un.org/en/ga/sixth/>) – unrestricted

Contains information relating to the work of the Sixth Committee during the session of the General Assembly, including the programme of work, details of the Bureau and of the Secretariat and coordinators of draft resolutions, as well as information on informal consultations, deadlines, side events and briefings. Daily “programme of the day” and “summaries of meetings” pages will be maintained throughout the session. Links are also provided to the e-deleGATE portal, related websites on legal matters, and UN Web TV.

The site also includes sub-pages dedicated to individual agenda items, in which the user can find, inter alia, summaries of prior work, links to documents (in all official languages), as well as links to the statements made by delegations in the Sixth Committee (including statements previously posted on the PaperSmart portal, since 2012).

Please note that delegations are requested to transmit their statements, well in advance of delivery, to estatements@un.org.

The website further serves as an archive of the work of the Committee, with links to the pages from previous sessions (1997 onwards).

e-deleGATE portal (accessible from the Sixth Committee website) – restricted access

An in-session tool for delegations, providing a common space for the circulation and co-sponsorship, where applicable, of draft resolutions (e-Sponsorship module); registration in the official list of delegations for the Sixth Committee (e-List of participants module); inscription in the list of speakers (e-Speakers module) for the debate on each agenda item as well as automatic inclusion in the Sixth Committee’s Announcements email list. Access to the portal is restricted to representatives of member States and of observer States (as registered by their missions).

Permanent Missions are invited to ensure that their respective Sixth Committee representatives are registered for the e- deleGATE portal. Such registration should be undertaken by the designated e-deleGATE focal point(s) within each mission. Registration is ongoing (i.e. no need to re-register for each session) and is discontinued upon de-registration by the respective mission.

The e-Delegate portal is restricted to representatives of member States and observer States
