The Permanent Mission of Greece to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honor, in accordance with the provisions of General Assembly resolution 71/145 and in response to the letter from the Secretary-General of 29 June 2018 (Reference: LA/COD/4), to convey the following information provided by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Hellenic Republic:

“Regarding the incident (paint throwing) against the Chancery of the Consulate General of Turkey in Athens on 4 April 2018, Greece wishes to inform the Secretary General that the police conducted an immediate and thorough investigation and the case was brought before the competent judicial authorities, with no criminal proceeding having been initiated. Ever since, Greece has reinforced the security measures for all diplomatic and consular missions of Turkey in its territory, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Vienna Conventions”.
