

The Permanent Mission of the State of Qatar to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Office of Legal Affairs of the United Nations and, in reference to the latter's note verbale dated 4 January 2024 (ref. LA/COD/11/1) inviting submission of information to be reflected in the report of the Secretary-General to the General Assembly on measures to eliminate international terrorism, has the honour to transmit the following:

- During the reporting period, no international terrorism-related incidents have been recorded by the National Counterterrorism Committee and no related trials nor criminal convictions have taken place.
- The State of Qatar, through Decree no. 47 (2021), ratified the 2005 Amendment to the 1980 Convention on the Physical Protection of Nuclear Material.
- The State of Qatar is in the process of acceding to international instruments related to terrorism to which it has not yet acceded.

The Permanent Mission of the State of Qatar avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Office of Legal Affairs the assurances of its highest consideration.
