The esteemed panelists will address linkages between the pending climate justice proceedings and ongoing legal discussions around environmental violations and core international crimes, including the proposals to incorporate environmental crimes such as "environmental degradation" and the "exploitation of natural resources" in the potential crimes against humanity before the UN General Assembly Sixth Committee.
