Thank you, Mr./Madam Chair,

My delegation fully aligns itself with the statement made by the European Union and we would like to make the following brief remark in our national capacity.

Austria attaches great importance to the United Nations Programme of Assistance in the Teaching, Study, Dissemination and Wider Appreciation of International Law. As outlined in the UN Charter, we are determined to contribute to conditions under which respect for the obligations arising from treaties and other sources of international law can be maintained. We are convinced that international relations should be conducted in compliance with international law.
