Mr. Chair, dear colleagues,

I have the honor to introduce the draft resolution under agenda item 82, entitled “Consideration of effective measures to enhance the protection, security and safety of diplomatic and consular missions and representatives”, as contained in document A/C.6/79/L.9, on behalf of the 27 co-sponsors listed in that document.

I am pleased to announce that the following Member States also join in sponsoring the draft resolution: Azerbaijan, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Cyprus and France.

The draft resolution is based on resolution 77/108 adopted in 2022 with necessary technical updates to extend the reporting mandates for the next biennial and to include the present item on the agenda of the General Assembly in its eighty-first session.

After the informal consultation on the draft resolution held on 4 November, I conclude that the text, as proposed, reflects a consensus among delegations. For this reason, I recommend that the Sixth Committee adopt the draft resolution without a vote.

Finally, allow me to take this opportunity to thank all delegations for their kind cooperation, as well as the colleagues at the Secretariat for their support and assistance.
