**JUDGE MARK P. PAINTER, Presiding Judge.** 

1. Under Article 18 of the Rules of Procedure of the Appeals Tribunal, this court set an

oral hearing on this case for 25 October 2010 at the United Nations Headquarters in New

York.

2. On 21 October 2010 the Commissioner-General of the United Nations Relief and

Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (Commissioner-General and UNRWA,

respectively), requested an adjournment of the oral hearing; the Appellant and the Secretary-

General filed their respective observations on 22 October 2010.

3. Counsel for UNRWA cannot participate even by video link, because UNRWA is in the

midst of a strike by its national staff who have locked the international staff and management

out of UNRWA's offices; and the case files and video facilities are inaccessible.

4. The Appellant submits that she is concerned over further prolongation of the

consideration of her case, which is certainly understandable.

We therefore VACATE the scheduling order and cancel the oral hearing of 25 October 2010.
