REQUEST FOR LEAVE TO FILE ADDITIONAL SUBMISSION

- 1. On 13 August 2010, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (Dispute Tribunal or UNDT) issued Judgment No. 2010/145 in respect of the application by Karina Basenko (Basenko). Basenko appealed that judgment on 28 September, and the Secretary-General filed his Answer on 15 November.
- 2. By e-mail dated 29 November 2010 to the Registry of the Appeals Tribunal, Basenko sought leave to file an additional submission, which she attached to her email.
- 3. Articles 8 and 9 Of the Appeals Tribunal's Rules of Procedure (Rules) provide for an appellant to submit an appeal form, accompanied by a brief, and for a respondent to submit an answer form, accompanied by a brief. There is no provision under the Rules for the parties to submit additional pleadings.
- 4. Under Article 31(1) of the Rules, the Appeals Tribunal may allow additional pleadings in exceptional circumstances.¹ The additional submission that Basenko seeks to file contains essentially her arguments supplementary to her appeal in response to the Secretary-General's Answer.
- 5. Basenko's application does not establish that there are exceptional circumstances justifying the need to file a reply to the Secretary-General's answer.
