## ORDER No. 48 (2011)

- 1. By Order No. 38, the Appeals Tribunal granted Françoise Lauritzen (Lauritzen) an extension of time until 26 April 2011 to file a brief in support of her appeal.<sup>1</sup> The Appeals Tribunal considered that the medical condition suffered by Lauritzen constituted exceptional circumstances which justified her extension request.
- 2. On 8 April 2011, Lauritzen filed a request for a further extension of time until October 2011 to file her appeal brief. In support of her request, she submits a medical certificate which certifies that Lauritzen will undergo medical treatment for several months.
- 3. I consider that the persisting medical condition suffered by Lauritzen constitutes exceptional circumstances and justifies her further request for an extension of time to file her appeal brief.
- 4. I therefore grant Lauritzen, under Article 7(3) of the Rules of Procedure of the Appeals Tribunal, a further extension of time to file her appeal brief by 1 November 2011.
