ORDER No. 52 (2011)

- 1. On 29 November 2010, David Andati-Amwayi (Andati-Amwayi) filed an appeal against Judgment No. UNDT/2010/183.
- 2. On 17 January 2011, the Registry of the United Nations Appeals Tribunal (Appeals Tribunal) was informed by the United Nations Office at Nairobi that Andati-Amwayi had passed away on 6 January 2011.
- 3. By communication dated 7 January 2011, the Office of Legal Affairs indicated that it was not opposed to a closing of the case. By email dated 9 March 2011, Ms. Annette Mwabi, the surviving spouse of Andati-Amwayi, informed the Registry of the Appeals Tribunal that she did not wish to pursue the appeal of her deceased husband.
- 4. A party may withdraw an appeal simply by giving notice and need not necessarily provide any further justification.¹ I see no reason to require Ms. Mwabi to pursue the appeal of her deceased husband.
- 5. For the foregoing reasons, there is no matter for adjudication by the Appeals Tribunal and the case is closed.
