ORDER No. 63 (2011)

1. On 5 July 2011, the Secretary-General of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) issued a decision in light of the 3 May 2011 Report of the Advisory Joint Appeals Board (AJAB) of ICAO on the appeal of the Appellant.
2. On 18 August 2011, the Appellant filed an appeal with the United Nations Appeals Tribunal regarding the decision issued by the Secretary-General of ICAO. On that same day, due to the confidential and private nature of some of the information contained in this matter, the Appellant filed a motion requesting that access to the filings in this matter be limited to authorized personnel within ICAO.
3. I have considered the Appellant's request and believe that due to the nature of the information contained in this case, as well as privacy concerns, the case warrants that access to the files and related information be restricted.
4. For the foregoing reason, I grant the Appellant's request and order that ICAO ensure that access to the Appellant's filings and related files be limited to authorized personnel that represent the Secretary-General of ICAO in this case.
