SECRETARY-GENERAL'S REQUEST FOR WITHDRAWAL OF APPEAL

1. The United Nations Appeals Tribunal (Appeals Tribunal) is seized of an appeal 2014-UNAT-593 filed by the Secretary-General of the United Nations on 24 March 2014 against a judgment rendered by the Dispute Tribunal in Geneva on 20 January 2014 in the case of *Terragnolo v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*.¹ On 2 February 2015, the Secretary-General filed a motion seeking to withdraw his appeal.

2. Considering that the Secretary-General has complied with the requirements of Article 18*bis*(2) of the Rules of Procedure of the Appeals Tribunal in that, before the opening date of the session during which the appeal is to be considered, he has informed the Appeals Tribunal in writing, with notice to the Respondent, that he wishes to discontinue such proceedings, I **GRANT** the Motion for withdrawal of his appeal and I **ORDER** that the appeal be removed from the register.
