## **REQUEST FOR WITHDRAWAL OF APPEAL**

1. On 10 December 2014, the Dispute Tribunal issued Judgment No. UNDT/2014/143 in the case of *Kusuma v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*. On 9 February 2015, Ms. Regina Kusuma filed an appeal form to the Judgment with the United Nations Appeals Tribunal (Appeals Tribunal). On 11 February 2015, Ms. Kusuma filed a motion seeking to withdraw her appeal.

2. The Appeals Tribunal has consistently held that “a party may withdraw an appeal simply by giving notice and need not necessarily provide any further justification”.<sup>1</sup>

3. I **GRANT** the Motion for withdrawal of Ms. Kusuma’s appeal and I **ORDER** that the case be closed.
