ORDER No. 213 (2015)

1. On 28 November 2014, Mr. Marwan Mizyed filed a motion for the expedited hearing of his case against Judgment No. UNDT/2014/060. On 14 January 2015, the Secretary-General indicated that he had no comments to the motion.
2. Mr. Mizyed requests the hearing of his case to be included in the docket for the 2015 Spring Session on an expedited basis. He states that as a result of the contested decision his financial and psychological status has deteriorated dramatically and the well-being of him and his family has been affected.
3. The Appeals Tribunal considers that in the interest of fairness to all parties seeking appeal and for the purpose of maintaining court efficiency, it would be inappropriate to grant Mr. Mizyed's motion absent a showing of exceptional circumstances, which has not been demonstrated in this case.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Mr. Mizyed's motion IS DENIED.
