REQUEST FOR WITHDRAWAL OF APPEAL

1. On 13 January 2015, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal in Geneva issued Judgment No. UNDT/2015/002 in the case of *Tran Nguyen v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*. On 13 March 2015, Mr. Nhan Tran Nguyen filed an appeal with the United Nations Appeals Tribunal.
2. On 20 May 2015, Mr. Tran Nguyen filed a motion seeking to withdraw his appeal on the ground that the parties had entered into a confidential Settlement and Release Agreement. On 29 May 2015, the Secretary-General filed his observations consenting to Mr. Tran Nguyen's request in its entirety.
3. The Appeals Tribunal has consistently held that "a party may withdraw an appeal simply by giving notice and need not necessarily provide any further justification".¹
4. The Motion for withdrawal of Mr. Tran Nguyen's appeal is **GRANTED** and the case shall be closed.
