## REQUEST FOR WITHDRAWAL OF APPEAL

- 1. On 27 April 2015, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (UNDT) in Geneva issued Order No. 93 (GVA/2015) in the case of *Melpignano v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*. On 27 May 2015, the Secretary-General appealed that order to the United Nations Appeals Tribunal (Appeals Tribunal). Mr. Cosimo Melpignano filed an answer on 23 June 2015.
- 2. On 23 October 2015, the Secretary-General filed a Motion to withdraw his appeal. He informed the Appeals Tribunal that the UNDT that had issued Order No. 93 (GVA/2015) subsequently, on 24 August 2015, issued Judgment No. UNDT/2015/075 on the merits, which effectively rendered his appeal of Order No. 93 (GVA/2015) moot. The Secretary-General has therefore filed the present motion "in the interest of judicial economy".
- 3. On 9 November 2015, Counsel for Mr. Melpignano confirmed that her client did not oppose the Motion to withdraw.
- 4. The Appeals Tribunal has routinely granted motions to withdraw appeals when the non-moving parties express no objection, as there is "no reason to require [a party] to pursue an appeal he [or she] no longer deems necessary in the context of his [or her] case".<sup>1</sup>
