ORDER No. 257 (2016)

1. On 31 December 2015, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (UNDT or Dispute Tribunal) in New York issued Judgment No. UNDT/2015/125 in the case of *Wilson v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*.

2. On 24 February 2016, Mr. Dan Campbell Wilson filed an appeal of the Judgment, and on 29 February 2016, the Secretary-General of the United Nations appealed the Judgment.

3. Under Article 18bis, subsection 1, of the Appeals Tribunal Rules of Procedure, “[t]he President may, at any time, either on a motion of a party or on his or her own volition, issue any order which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties”.

4. In light of the fact that the two appeals before us challenge the same UNDT Judgment, Judgment No. UNDT/2015/125, it is “appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties” to consolidate these two appeals for all purposes.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the appeals filed in Case Nos. 2016-902 and 2016-906 should be consolidated for all purposes.
