ORDER No. 260 (2016)

1. On 11 November 2015, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (UNDT) in New York issued Judgment No. UNDT/2015/110/Corr.1 in the cases of *Nguyen-Kropp and Postica v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*.

2. On 11 January 2016, Ms. Ai Loan Nguyen-Kropp and Mr. Florin Postica filed separate appeals of the Judgment.

3. Under Article 18*bis*, subsection 1, of the Appeals Tribunal Rules of Procedure, “[t]he President may, at any time, either on a motion of a party or on his or her own volition, issue any order which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties”.

4. In light of the fact that the two appeals before us challenge the same Judgment No. UNDT/2015/110/Corr.1, it is “appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties” to consolidate these two appeals for all purposes.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the appeals filed in Case Nos. 2016-884 and 2016-885 should be consolidated for all purposes.
