V.

Secretary-General of the United Nations (Respondent) Order No. 267 (2016)

- 1. On 24 May 2016, the United Nations Appeals Tribunal (Appeals Tribunal) issued four judgments in the cases of *Nielsen v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*. One of them (Judgment No. 2016-UNAT-647) disposed of Ms. Olga Nielsen's appeal in Case No. 2015-735 by remanding a discrete issue in her case to the United Nations Dispute Tribunal for reconsideration.
- 2. Ms. Nielsen has since filed two motions under Case No. 2015-735. On 30 May 2016, she filed a "Motion re: UNAT Judgement 2016-UNAT-647", in which she requested leave to "provide one more proof" about her work performance and "some additional proofs of poor performance of PSB top managers". In a "Motion re my divorce" dated 11 June 2016, Ms. Nielsen informed the Appeals Tribunal that her husband had filed for a divorce and requested assistance in obtaining employment with the United Nations Population Fund.
- 3. These two motions are not receivable, because the Appeals Tribunal has already disposed of Case No. 2015-735 by Judgment No. 2016-UNAT-647. Once this Tribunal has issued a judgment, it is no longer seised of the matter; it is *functus officio*.
- 4. For the foregoing reasons, Ms. Nielsen's motions should be denied.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Ms. Nielsen's two motions of 30 May 2016 and 11 June 2016 filed under Case No. 2015-735 **ARE DENIED**.
