- 1. On 1 February 2017, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (UNDT or Dispute Tribunal) in New York issued Judgment No. UNDT/2017/006 in the case of *Auda v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*.
- 2. On 3 April 2017, the Secretary-General of the United Nations filed an appeal of the Judgment to the United Nations Appeals Tribunal (Appeals Tribunal) (Case No. 2017-1068), and on the same day, Mr. Hesham Auda appealed the Judgment (Case No. 2017-1070).
- 3. Under Article 18*bis*, subsection 1, of the Appeals Tribunal Rules of Procedure, "[t]he President may, at any time, either on a motion of a party or on his or her own volition, issue any order which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties".
- 4. In light of the fact that the two appeals before us challenge the same UNDT Judgment, Judgment No. UNDT/2017/006, it is "appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties" to consolidate these two appeals for all purposes.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the appeals filed in Case Nos. 2017-1068 and 2017-1070 should be consolidated for all purposes.
