Order No. 305 (2017)

1. On 24 October 2017, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (UNDT or Dispute Tribunal) in Nairobi issued Judgment on Receivability No. UNDT/2017/083 in the case of *Koumoin v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*.

2. On 25 October 2017, Mr. Mathieu-Credo Koumoin appealed the Judgment to the United Nations Appeals Tribunal (Appeals Tribunal) and the Secretary-General filed his answer on 29 November 2017.

3. On 30 November 2017, Mr. Koumoin filed a motion seeking leave to file additional pleadings in response to the Secretary-General's answer to his appeal. On 11 December 2017, the Secretary-General filed his response opposing the motion.

4. Under the Appeals Tribunal Statute, Mr. Koumoin is not entitled to file a response to the answer to his appeal. Article 31(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Section II.A.3 of Practice Direction No. 1 allow the Appeals Tribunal to permit a party to file additional pleadings after the filing of the answer if there are exceptional circumstances for doing so.<sup>1</sup> However, Mr. Koumoin has not demonstrated the existence of exceptional

circumstances; he merely seeks to express his disagreement with the statements made by the Secretary-General in his answer and reiterates the arguments already contained in his appeal.<sup>2</sup> Thus, Mr. Koumoin's motion for leave to file additional pleadings is denied.

## **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Mr. Koumoin's motion **IS DENIED**.

**IT IS ALSO ORDERED** that the Registrar shall not include the motion and annex thereto, as well as the Secretary-General's response thereto, in the case file.
