Order No. 341 (2019)

1. On 2 November 2018, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (UNDT) in Nairobi issued Judgment No. UNDT/2018/108 in the case of *Ross v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*.
2. On 18 December 2018, the Secretary-General of the United Nations filed an appeal of the Judgment to the United Nations Appeals Tribunal (Appeals Tribunal) (Case No. 2018-1220), and on 7 January 2019, Mr. Felix Ross also appealed the Judgment (Case No. 2019-1221).
3. Under Article 18 *bis*, subsection 1, of the Appeals Tribunal's Rules of Procedure, "[t]he President may, at any time, either on a motion of a party or on his or her own volition, issue any order which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties".
4. In light of the fact that the two appeals before us challenge the same UNDT Judgment, Judgment No. UNDT/2018/108, it is "appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties" to consolidate these two appeals for all purposes.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the appeals filed in Case Nos. 2018-1220 and 2019-1221 should be consolidated for all purposes.
