

Order No. 351 (2019)

1. On 9 January 2019, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (UNDT) in Nairobi issued Judgment No. UNDT/2019/003 in the case of *Tosi v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*.
2. On 11 March 2019, Mr. Alejandro Tosi filed an appeal of the UNDT Judgment to the United Nations Appeals Tribunal (Appeals Tribunal) (Case No. 2019-1239). On the same day, the Secretary-General also appealed the UNDT Judgment (Case No. 2019-1240).
3. Under Article 18*bis*, subsection 1, of the Appeals Tribunal Rules of Procedure, “[t]he President may, at any time, either on a motion of a party or on his or her own volition, issue any order which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties”.
4. In light of the fact that these two appeals challenge the same UNDT Judgment, it is “appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties” to consolidate them for all purposes.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the appeals filed in Case Nos. 2019-1239 and 2019-1240 should be consolidated for all purposes.
