**Order No. 364 (2020)**

1. On 28 June 2019, the United Nations Appeals Tribunal (Appeals Tribunal) issued Judgment No. 2019-UNAT-942 in the case of *El Shaer v. Commissioner-General of United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East*. In respect of this Judgment, Mr. Tamer El Shaer has filed two applications: one for execution (Case No. 2019-1324), and the other for interpretation (Case No. 2019-1329).
2. Under Article 18*bis* of the Appeals Tribunal Rules of Procedure, “[t]he President may, at any time, either on a motion of a party or on his or her own volition, issue any order which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties”.
3. In light of the fact that the two appeals before us concern the same Appeals Tribunal Judgment, it is “appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties” to consolidate them for all purposes.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the appeals filed in Case Nos. 2019-1324 and 2019-1329 should be consolidated for all purposes.
