REQUEST FOR WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION

1. On 26 June 2020, the United Nations Appeals Tribunal issued Judgment No. UNAT-2020-1024 in the case of *Nyawa v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*. Mr. George Nyawa filed an application for interpretation of the above judgment on 22 September 2020.
2. On 29 September 2020, Mr. Nyawa filed a motion for withdrawal of application stating that the Respondent had initiated corrective action, to his satisfaction. On 23 October 2020, the Secretary-General responded that he had no objection to the withdrawal of the application.
3. The Appeals Tribunal has consistently held that “a party may withdraw an appeal simply by giving notice and need not necessarily provide any further justification”.¹
4. The Motion for withdrawal of Mr. Nyawa’s appeal is **GRANTED** and the case shall be closed.
