## REQUEST FOR WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION

- 1. On 26 June 2020, the United Nations Appeals Tribunal issued Judgment No. UNAT-2020-1024 in the case of *Nyawa v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*. Mr. George Nyawa filed an application for interpretation of the above judgment on 22 September 2020.
- 2. On 29 September 2020, Mr. Nyawa filed a motion for withdrawal of application stating that the Respondent had initiated corrective action, to his satisfaction. On 23 October 2020, the Secretary-General responded that he had no objection to the withdrawal of the application.
- 3. The Appeals Tribunal has consistently held that "a party may withdraw an appeal simply by giving notice and need not necessarily provide any further justification".
- 4. The Motion for withdrawal of Mr. Nyawa's appeal is **GRANTED** and the case shall be closed.
