**ORDER No. 465 (2022)**

1. On 30 October 2020, the United Nations Appeals Tribunal (Appeals Tribunal or UNAT) issued Judgment No. 2020-UNAT-1055 in the matter of *Ashraf Ismail abed allah Zaqqout v. Commissioner-General of the United Nations Relief and Works for Palestine Refugees in the Near East*, wherein the Appeals Tribunal dismissed Mr. Zaqqout's appeal.
2. On 5 October 2021, Mr. Zaqqout filed an Application for Correction of the above Judgment, and the Commissioner-General filed his comments on 13 November 2021. This case was registered as Case 2021-1619.
3. On 20 November 2021, Mr. Zaqqout filed an Application for Revision of the same Judgment, and the Commissioner-General filed his comments on 4 January 2022. This case was registered as Case 2021-1630.
4. Under Article 18*bis*(1) of the Appeals Tribunal Rules of Procedure: "[t]he President may, at any time, either on a motion of a party or on his or her own volition, issue any order which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties".

5. In light of the fact that the two applications before us challenge the same UNAT Judgment, it is “appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties” to consolidate them for all purposes.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the applications filed in Case Nos. 2021-1619 and 2021-1630 be consolidated for all purposes.
