ORDER No. 466 (2022)

1. On 13 June 2021, the Dispute Tribunal of the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA DT) issued Judgment No. UNRWA/DT/2021/027 in the matter of *Khalaf, Allari and Hussein* wherein the UNRWA DT dismissed the applications as not receivable.
2. On 1 October 2021, the three staff members filed separate appeals with the Appeals Tribunal against the above-referenced Judgment. They are registered as Case Nos. 2021-1616 (Allari), 2021-1617 (Khalaf) and 2021-1618 (Hussein). The Commissioner-General filed his answers on 2 December 2021.
3. Under Article 18*bis*(1) of the Appeals Tribunal Rules of Procedure: “[t]he President may, at any time, either on a motion of a party or on his or her own volition, issue any order which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties”.

4. In light of the fact that the three appeals before us challenge the same UNRWA DT Judgment, it is “appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties” to consolidate them for all purposes.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the appeals filed in Case Nos. 2021-1616, 2021-1617 and 2021-1618 be consolidated for all purposes.
