ORDER No. 467 (2022)

1. On 29 July 2021, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (Dispute Tribunal or UNDT) in Nairobi issued Judgment No. UNDT/2021/091 in the matter of *Applicant v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*.
2. On 27 September 2021, Appellant AAA appealed the UNDT Judgment to the Appeals Tribunal. The case was registered as Case No. 2021-1608. On the same day, the Secretary-General also appealed the same Judgment. The case was registered as Case No. 2021-1612.
3. Under Article 18*bis*(1) of the Appeals Tribunal Rules of Procedure: “[t]he President may, at any time, either on a motion of a party or on his or her own volition, issue any order which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties”.
4. In light of the fact that the two appeals before us challenge the same UNDT Judgment, it is “appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties” to consolidate them for all purposes.
