ORDER No. 480 (2022)

1. On 30 November 2021, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (Dispute Tribunal or UNDT) in Nairobi issued Judgment No. UNDT/2021/144, and on 7 December 2021, it also issued Judgment UNDT/2021/151. Both UNDT Judgments concern Mr. David Michael Antoine and arise from the same or closely related underlying facts and circumstances.
2. On 31 January 2022, Mr. Antoine appealed the Judgment UNDT/2021/144 to the Appeals Tribunal. The case was registered as Case No. 2022-1660. On 4 April 2022, the Secretary-General filed his answer.
3. On 7 February 2022, Mr. Antoine appealed the UNDT Judgment UNDT/2021/151, this case was registered as No. 2022-1663. On 11 April 2022, the Secretary-General filed his answer.
4. Pursuant to Article 18*bis*(1) of the Appeals Tribunal Rules of Procedure: “[t]he President may, at any time, either on a motion of a party or on his or her own volition, issue any order which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties”. I therefore direct that these cases be consolidated for hearing and judgment.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the appeals filed in Case Nos. 2022-1660 and 2022-1663 be consolidated for all purposes.
