ORDER No. 482 (2022)

1. On 23 December 2021, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (Dispute Tribunal or UNDT) in Nairobi issued Judgment No. UNDT/2021/161. On 25 March 2022, it also issued Judgment UNDT/2022/029. Both UNDT Judgments concern Mr. Antonio Ponce-Gonzalez and arise from the same or closely related underlying facts and circumstances.
2. On 21 February 2022, the Secretary-General appealed the Judgment UNDT/2021/161 to the Appeals Tribunal. This appeal was registered as Case No. 2022-1669. On 21 April 2022, Mr. Ponce-Gonzalez filed his answer.
3. On 23 May 2022, Mr. Ponce-Gonzalez appealed the Judgment UNDT/2022/029, which was registered as No. 2022-1694. On 25 July 2022, the Secretary-General filed his answer.
4. Pursuant to Article 18*bis*(1) of the Appeals Tribunal Rules of Procedure: “[t]he President may, at any time, either on a motion of a party or on his or her own volition, issue any order which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties”. I therefore direct that these cases be consolidated for hearing and judgment.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the appeals filed in Case Nos. 2022-1669 and 2022-1694 be consolidated for all purposes.
