ORDER No. 483 (2022)

1. On 23 March 2022, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (Dispute Tribunal or UNDT) in New York issued Judgment Nos. UNDT/2022/028, and UNDT/2022/033. Both UNDT Judgments concern Mr. Andrey Chernov and arise from the same or closely related underlying facts and circumstances.
2. On 23 May 2022, Mr. Chernov appealed both Judgments to the Appeals Tribunal. The appeals were registered as Case Nos. 2022-1692 and 2022-1693 respectively. On 25 July 2022, the Secretary-General filed his answers to both appeals.
3. Pursuant to Article 18*bis*(1) of the Appeals Tribunal Rules of Procedure: “[t]he President may, at any time, either on a motion of a party or on his or her own volition, issue any order which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties”. I therefore direct that these cases be consolidated for hearing and judgment.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the appeals filed in Case Nos. 2022-1692 and 2022-1693 be consolidated for all purposes.
