ORDER No. 485 (2022)

1. On 26 April 2022, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (Dispute Tribunal or UNDT) in Geneva issued Judgment No. UNDT/2022/039 in the matter of *Iram v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*.
2. On 25 June 2022, Mr. Iram appealed the above UNDT Judgment to the Appeals Tribunal. His appeal was registered as Case No. 2022-1704. On 27 June 2022, the Secretary-General appealed the same Judgment. This appeal was registered as Case No. 2022-1705.
3. Under Article 18*bis*(1) of the Appeals Tribunal Rules of Procedure: “[t]he President may, at any time, either on a motion of a party or on his or her own volition, issue any order which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties”.
4. In light of the fact that the two appeals before us challenge the same UNDT Judgment, it is “appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties” to consolidate them for all purposes.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the appeals filed in Case Nos. 2022-1704 and 2022-1705 be consolidated for all purposes.
