ORDER No. 579 (2024)

1. On 7 November 2023, the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (UNDT or Dispute Tribunal) issued Judgment No. UNDT/2023/121 and Judgment No. UNDT/2023/122 in the cases of *Reilly v. Secretary-General of the United Nations*.
2. Both UNDT Judgments concern the Appellant Ms. Emma Reilly and arise from related underlying facts and circumstances.
3. On 8 January 2024, Ms. Reilly filed an appeal against Judgment No. UNDT/2023/121 before the United Nations Appeals Tribunal (UNAT or Appeals Tribunal). That same day, Ms. Reilly also filed an appeal against Judgment No. UNDT/2023/122. The appeals were registered as Case No. 2024-1888 and Case No. 2024-1890, respectively. On 11 March 2024, the Secretary-General filed his answers to the appeals.
4. Pursuant to Article 18*bis*(1) of the Appeals Tribunal Rules of Procedure: “[t]he President may, at any time, either on a motion of a party or on his or her own volition, issue any order which appears to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious management of the case and to do justice to the parties”. I therefore direct that these cases be consolidated for hearing and judgment.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the appeals filed in Case Nos. 2024-1888 and 2024-1890 be consolidated for all purposes.
