**JUDGMENT AND ORDER STRIKING
OUT**

1. The Applicant was employed at the level of Assistant Secretary-General as the Deputy Joint Special Representative of the Chairman of the African Union and Secretary-General of the United Nations, with the United Nations Mission and African Union Mission in Darfur (UNAMID). He was stationed in El-Fasher, Darfur, Sudan. On 16 March 2010 he filed an Application before the United Nations Dispute Tribunal in Nairobi (UNDT). He challenged the decision of the Assistant Secretary-General for Human Resources to reprimand him for allegedly having violated various provisions of the Staff Rules, Regulations and Administrative issuances on the obligations of staff members to meet financial disclosure requirements.
2. Following a directions hearing on 21 September 2010, the Tribunal issued Order 189 granting the Applicant's Motion for Referral of this case to mediation.
3. On 29 September 2010, the Director of Mediation Services in the Office of the United Nations Ombudsman and Mediation Services notified the Tribunal that the case was suitable for mediation proceedings. On his request the Tribunal suspended the proceedings for three months for completion of the process.
4. The Tribunal granted 2 requests for the extension of the suspension first to 30 December 2010 and then to 21 January 2011.
5. On 20 January 2011, the Registry was notified by the Director of Mediation Services that the dispute has been successfully resolved between the Parties.

The Tribunal congratulates the parties on reaching the settlement. It notes the agreement between the Parties, and the Applicant's notice of withdrawal, and orders that the matter of *Yonis v Secretary-General of the United Nations* be struck out.
