Introduction

1. On 12 April 2018, the Applicant made an application to the Tribunal. On

17 May 2018, the Respondent filed his reply.

2. On 4 September 2018, the parties attended a case management discussion

during which the Tribunal directed them to advise it as to whether they would agree

to initiate discussions to resolve the matter.

3. On 24 September 2018, the parties informed the Tribunal that they had

initiated discussions. This was followed on 7 December 2018 by the Applicant

filing a motion to withdraw the application, noting that the parties had reached a

full and final settlement and that there was to be no right of reinstatement.

Consideration

4. The Tribunal accepts the motion to withdraw the application on the terms

requested. It notes that the amicable settlement of disputes is encouraged and is

important, especially in circumstances where there is an ongoing employment

relationship. The parties are to be praised for the approach taken in this matter.

5. The Tribunal, on its own motion, has decided to anonymize this judgment

in view that since the matter was amicably resolved it is not appropriate for the

Applicant's name to be disclosed in a public document.

Conclusion

6. The Applicant's motion to withdraw the application is granted and this case

is hereby closed, with, as requested, no right of reinstatement.
