ORDER ON AN APPLICATION FOR SUSPENSION OF ACTION PENDING MANAGEMENT EVALUATION

Introduction

1. By application filed on 12 April 2018, the Applicant requests suspension of action, pending management evaluation, of the "the decision(s) in the past 60 days to re-authorize the funding for the informal investigations, surveillance, research, info gathering, evidence collection and other activities carried out against [the Applicant] by the PFP Division senior management".

2. The application was served on the Respondent, who filed his reply on 16 April 2018, noting that the decisions for which the Applicant requested management evaluation and suspension of action do not exist.

Consideration

3. There is no evidence in support of the "administrative decision(s)" for which the Applicant requests suspension of action. Furthermore, the Tribunal has no reason to doubt the Respondent's statement that no such decision(s) exist. It follows that in the absence of a decision/decisions to examine, the instant application cannot be entertained.

Anonymization

4. The Tribunal is aware that, in the name of transparency, an Applicant's name shall normally appear on judicial decisions. However, given the circumstances surrounding the current application, the Tribunal finds it appropriate to anonymize the present order to protect the Applicant.

Conclusion

5. In view of the foregoing, the application for suspension of action is rejected.
