## **Introduction**

1. At the time of the application, the Applicant held a permanent appointment, and was serving as a National Programme Assistant at the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (“UNODC”).
2. On 21 May 2019, she filed an application before the United Nations Dispute Tribunal to challenge the Respondent’s decision to temporarily reassign her functions as Head of the UNODC Office in Albania.
3. The Respondent filed his Reply on 24 June 2019. It is the Respondent’s case that the application is not receivable and should be dismissed as such. He also argues that the impugned decision, as described by the Applicant, was lawfully made.

## **Considerations and Order**

4. The Tribunal has reviewed the parties’ submissions. For the fair and expeditious management and disposal of this case, the Tribunal makes the following orders:
  - a. The Applicant is directed to file her response to the Respondent’s reply, addressing his arguments on receivability and the merits, by **Friday, 19 February 2021**;
  - b. The Respondent may file his submission in response to the Applicant’s above response by **5 March 2021**.
5. The Tribunal finds that this matter is suitable for determination on the basis of the parties’ written submissions.
