Introduction

1. On 14 April 2020, the Applicant filed an application contesting the "decision

denying the Applicant compensation for moral and material harm due to irregularities

vitiating the conduct of the investigation into his harassment complaint".

2. On 18 May 2020, the Respondent replied that the application was not receivable

because it did not contest an administrative decision, and that, in any case, the

application is without merit.
