**ORDER

Introduction

1. On 15 January 2020, the Applicant, a staff member with UN Women in Belgium, filed an application to contest the decision of the Office of Internal Oversight Services (“OIOS”) not to launch an investigation into his complaint against a staff member of the United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo (“UNMIK”).
2. On 15 February 2021, pursuant to Order No. 11 (GVA/2021), the Respondent filed a complete reply. Two annexes were filed under seal.
3. On 23 February 2021, without leave from the Tribunal, the Applicant filed his response to the Respondent’s reply of 15 February 2021 before under seal filings were made available to him.
4. On the same day, the under seal filings were made available to the Applicant.

Consideration

5. Having reviewed the parties’ submissions, the Tribunal considers that the case can be decided based on the papers before it.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

6. By **4 p.m. on Friday, 12 March 2021 (Geneva time)**, the Applicant is to file his statement responding to the Respondent’s reply, which is solely to be based on the submissions and evidence on record. The statement shall not exceed five pages, using font Times New Roman, font size 12 pts and 1.5 line spacing.
7. Thereafter, the Tribunal will decide the case based on the papers before it.
