### **Introduction**

1. By Order No. 112 (GVA/2022) of 23 November 2022, the Tribunal, *inter alia*, ordered the parties to attend a hearing on the merits via Microsoft Teams on 12 December 2022, commencing at 9.30 a.m. (Geneva time).
2. On 12 December 2022, the hearing on the merits took place as scheduled.

### **Consideration**

3. Having heard the parties' oral submissions and the witnesses' testimonies at the hearing, the Tribunal decided to direct the parties to file their closing submissions in writing within 10 days of this Order.
4. Noting that during the hearing, the Respondent orally requested leave to file further submissions on damages in case the contested decision is considered unlawful, the Tribunal finds it appropriate to direct the parties to provide in their written closing submissions comments on the procedural irregularities related to the Applicant's retroactive separation from service.
5. Pursuant to art. 19 of the Tribunal's Rules of Procedure, for a fair and expeditious disposal of the case, and to do justice to the parties,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

6. By **Friday, 23 December 2022**, the parties file their respective written closing submission.
