**ORDER

Introduction

1. By application registered under Case No. UNDT/GVA/2021/004, the Applicant contests the “decision not to take any action on [her] complaint of abuse of authority” against the Executive Director, Office of Administration of Justice (“OAJ”) and the Principal Registrar, OAJ.

2. Pursuant to Order No. 28 (GVA/2023), a case management discussion (“CMD”) was held on 26 April 2023 with the participation of the Applicant and Counsel for the Respondent.

Consideration

3. At the CMD, the Tribunal heard the parties’ position concerning the subject-matter under adjudication, holding a hearing on the merits, the Applicant’s requests for disclosure of evidence, and the issue of conflict of interest she raised in written submissions. Also, the Tribunal recalled the Respondent’s challenge to the receivability of the application, and the Applicant’s arguments in this respect in her rejoinder of 18 April 2023.

4. The Tribunal informed the parties that it would pronounce itself in due course after the CMD on the issues related to discovery and of holding a hearing. In the meantime, concerning the issue of the receivability of the application, the Tribunal finds it appropriate to give an opportunity to the Respondent to comment on the Applicant’s arguments in her above-mentioned rejoinder.

Conclusion

5. In view of the foregoing, IT IS ORDERED THAT the Respondent shall file his comments on the arguments on receivability in the Applicant’s 18 April 2023 rejoinder by **Friday, 5 May 2023**.
