General Assembly has consistently encouraged alternative dispute resolution, the

Tribunal finds it appropriate to encourage the parties to explore the possibility of

having the dispute between them resolved without recourse to further litigation.

5. By **Friday**, **8 December 2023**, the Applicant shall file a rejoinder;

6. The parties shall explore resolving the dispute amicably and revert to the

Tribunal in this respect by Friday, 15 December 2023.
