1. By application filed on 17 August 2023, the Applicant contests the decision

denying him his request for 16 weeks of parental leave under provisional staff

rule 6.3 (see ST/SGB/2023/1) and ST/AI/2023/2 (Parental leave and Family leave).

3. Having perused the case file, the Tribunal considers it appropriate and in the

interest of justice to direct the Applicant to file a rejoinder.
