Introduction

1. By application filed on 21 July 2023 and completed on 27 October 2023, the Applicant contests the decision to separate her from service on disciplinary grounds with compensation in lieu of notice, and with a 25% termination indemnity.
2. On 5 December 2023, the Respondent filed his reply.
3. Between December 2023 and March 2024, the Applicant made several submissions regarding the Respondent's reply and produced additional information.
4. On 11 March 2024, the Respondent informed the Tribunal that it was not possible to resolve the matter amicably.

Consideration

5. Having reviewed the evidence on record and the parties' submissions to date, the Tribunal considers itself sufficiently informed to render its judgment without the need for additional disclosure of evidence or the holding of a hearing on the merits.
6. Pursuant to art. 19 of the Tribunal's Rules of Procedure, and for the fair disposal of the case, the parties will be instructed to file their respective closing submission. Upon the filing of closing submissions, the Tribunal will move forward with adjudicating the case.

Conclusion

7. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED THAT the parties shall file their respective closing submission by **Friday, 19 July 2024**, which shall exclusively refer to the evidence already on file.
