Introduction

1. By application filed on 29 April 2024, the Applicant contests the decision to not investigate allegations related to the leaking of his personal information.
2. On 3 June 2024, the Respondent filed his reply, *inter alia*, challenging the receivability of the application.

Consideration

Filing of a rejoinder

3. Having perused the case file, the Tribunal considers it appropriate and in the interest of justice to grant the Applicant leave to file a rejoinder. The Applicant should *inter alia* address in it the receivability challenge that the Respondent raised.

Amicable settlement

4. Recalling that the General Assembly has consistently encouraged alternative dispute resolution, the Tribunal finds it also appropriate to encourage the parties to explore the possibility of having the dispute between them resolved without recourse to further litigation.

Conclusion

5. In view of the foregoing, it is ORDERED THAT:
 - a. By **Monday, 26 August 2024**, the Applicant shall file his rejoinder; and
 - b. The parties shall explore resolving the dispute amicably and revert to the Tribunal in this respect by **Monday, 2 September 2024**.
