Introduction

1. By application filed on 13 November 2023, the Applicant, a staff member at the United Nations Development Program (“UNDP”), contests the decision not to select him for a Procurement Analyst (NOB) position.
2. On 12 December 2023, the Respondent filed his reply.
3. By Order No. 15 (GVA/2024) of 6 February 2024, the Tribunal instructed the Applicant to file his comments on the Respondent’s reply by 7 March 2024. It also instructed the parties to explore amicable settlement and revert to the Tribunal in this respect by 14 March 2024.
4. On 28 February 2024, the Applicant filed his comments on the reply.
5. On 12 March 2024, the Respondent informed the Tribunal that the parties explored the possibility of an informal settlement but that the matter was not able to be resolved amicably.

Consideration

6. Having examined the parties’ submissions to date and the evidence on record, the Tribunal finds that it is fully informed on the matter and that the case can be determined without holding a hearing. Consequently, the parties can proceed to file closing submissions.
7. Pursuant to art. 19 of the Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure,

IT IS ORDERED THAT

8. By **Thursday, 19 September 2024**, the parties shall file their respective closing submission, which shall:
 - a. Exclusively refer to the evidence already on file; and
